ATHLETIC PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT



The essential elements of character building and ethics in athletics are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility,

fairness, caring and good citizenship. The highest potential of athletics is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

Therefore I agree:

- 1) I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices.
- 2) I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss or confront coaches at the athletic venue, and will take time to speak to coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- 3) I will remember that athletes participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- 4) I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his or her performance
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of 5) race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have 6) for my child to win.
- 7) I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that could endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
- 8) I (and my guests) will be positive role models for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and demonstrating positive support for all players' coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice, or sporting event.
- 9) I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing or taunting; refusing to shake hands; using profane language or gestures; and/or physical violence.
- 10) I will respect the neighborhood surrounding Los Amigos Park. Excessive noise and trash will not be tolerated.
- 11) I understand that any violation of this code of conduct will be cause for dismissal, suspension, or permanent expulsion from future athletic contests.
